

# Year 2 Curriculum Map - Autumn 2



<b><u>Subject</u></b>	<b><u>Overview</u></b>
<b>Writing</b>	Lost and Found - Children will continue to write in accurately punctuated sentences, use effective vocabulary and will be taught to use conjunctions to join clauses. Children will create and illustrate their own retelling of Lost and Found to share with Reception children. They will also look at penguin poetry and reciting poems for an audience.
<b>Reading</b>	Lost and Found - Children will use inference and deduction to make predictions and will use their comprehension skills to answer questions about the story and characters. Phonics – Children will follow the Read, Write Inc. programme working at their ability with regular assessment. Reading Gems – Children will be taught the fundamental skills for effective reading through looking at a range of genres.
<b>Maths</b>	Calculation - Children will continue to become efficient with their addition and subtraction strategies and begin to use these to solve real life problems including adding coins and working out change (money).
<b>Science</b>	Being Healthy - Children will learn about the importance of healthy eating, exercise and hygiene. They will have the opportunity to plan and prepare an investigation, make a prediction and discuss their findings.
<b>RE</b>	Religious Celebrations - Children will learn about similarities and differences between different religious festivals and will explore the question ‘Why does Christmas matter to Christians?’
<b>PSHE</b>	Celebrating Differences – Children will learn to identify what makes them and their friends special and will describe the similarities and differences between us.
<b>Geography</b>	Local Environment – Children will revisit compass points and giving directions. They will conduct simple fieldwork to study the geography of the school as well as looking at map symbols.
<b>Art</b>	William Morris - Children will learn the difference between block and mono printing and use this to create their own wrapping paper in the style of William Morris.
<b>Computing</b>	Using the internet - The children will learn how to use the internet correctly and efficiently to get the results they want. They will learn about the importance of E-Safety.
<b>PE</b>	Swimming and ball skills
