

Year 2 Curriculum Map – Spring 2



<u>Subject</u>	<u>Overview</u>
Writing	The Queen’s Knickers – Children will be taught how to use a range of punctuation, to use commas in a list, and will continue to use the correct tense throughout a piece of writing. The children will discover that the Queen has a different pair of knickers for every occasion. The children will finish the unit with a visit from ‘The Queen’ and will write a recount of what happened!
Reading	Queens Knickers – Children will inference and deduction to make predications and will share their opinions of the text. Phonics – Children will follow the Read, Write Inc. programme working at their ability with regular assessment. Reading Gems –Children will be taught the fundamental skills for effective reading through comprehension questions from a range of genres.
Maths	Data, Shape and Time – Children will learn how to collect, present and interpret data in different ways, they will learn the properties of common 2d and 3d shapes and will practise telling the time to 5 minute intervals.
RE	The Holy Week – Children will be taught the importance of Easter in the ‘big story’ of the Bible. They will understand that Jesus showed he was willing to forgive all people and that Christians believe Jesus builds a bridge between God and humans.
PSHE	Healthy Me – Children will be taught to compare their own and their friends’ choices and will be given opportunities to express how it feels to make healthy and safe choices
History	Local History - Children will learn about Kidderminster carpet factory and how Rowland Hill made history!
Art	Monet- Children will create two images to compare the effect of light and shade in the style of Monet and the Haystacks.
Computing	Algorithms - The children will be taught how to use an algorithm and when to use one. They will be able to understand what an algorithm is and state the use for computers to use them.
PE	Outdoor Adventurous Activities and multi-skills/team games.
