

Year 2 Curriculum Map – Summer 1



<u>Subject</u>	<u>Overview</u>
Writing	SPaG – This term is short and children will have SATs during it. Therefore we do not use a book to drive our English but instead we have a focus on spelling, punctuation and grammar throughout a range of different types of writing (instructions, diaries, recounts, wanted posters etc.) Children will also be given ‘edit a sentence’ opportunities.
Reading	Phonics – Children will follow the Read, Write Inc. programme working at their ability with regular assessment. Reading Gems – Children will be taught the fundamental skills for effective reading through comprehension questions from a range of genres.
Maths	Measure – Children will learn about the different ways we use measure in our lives, including length, weight, mass, capacity and temperature.
RE	The Gospels – Children will explore the ‘Gospels’ and make links to Jesus bringing good news. They will recognise that Jesus gives instructions about how to behave and will be encouraged to ask questions about whether Jesus’ good news is only good news for Christians or if there are things for anyone to learn, exploring different ideas.
PSHE	Relationships – Children be taught how identify things that cause conflict between friends and to explain why these conflicts arise. They will be taught positive problem solving techniques to help settle conflict.
Art	Form – children will use clay to make a 3d sculpture of a flower.
PE	Dance and athletics.

SATs this term
