

Year 2 Curriculum Map – Summer 2



<u>Subject</u>	<u>Overview</u>
Writing	The Mousehole Cat – Children will explore this text and develop their skills as a writer. Children will use conjunctions, effective vocabulary and different suffixes to compose descriptions, narratives, letters and diaries.
Reading	The Mousehole Cat – looking at new vocabulary Phonics – Children will follow the Read, Write Inc. programme working at their ability with regular assessment. Reading Gems – Children will be taught the fundamental skills for effective reading through comprehension questions from a range of genres.
Maths	Position and movement – Children will learn the correct vocabulary to describe movement and rotation using clockwise and anti-clockwise and in terms of right angles for quarter, half and three-quarter turns. Children will also revisit key concepts in preparation for the move to key stage 2.
RE	Children will explore the question ‘How do Christians use Bible stories and texts to guide their lives?’
PSHE	Changing Me – Children will be taught to recognise the physical differences between boys and girls, to use the correct names for parts of the body and appreciate that parts of their body are private. They will also learn about difference in personality and behaviour.
Science	Plants – Children will observe and describe how seeds and bulbs grow into mature plants. They will carry out an investigation to find out the best conditions for healthy plants to grow.
History	Amazing Grace – Children will learn about the RNLI, the life of Grace Darling and why she is remembered today.
Computing	Skills - Children will reflect on the skills which they have learnt and will apply them. They will apply their skills through the process of blogging.
DT	Stable Structures – Children will design and make a lighthouse thinking about using materials that are fit for purpose.
PE	Gymnastics, net and wall ball skills.
