

Year One Curriculum Map

Maths	Place value-counting forwards and backwards, representing numbers, find one more and one less, comparing numbers. Vocabulary-greater than, more than, less than, fewer, equal.
English	'The Enormous Turnip'. Children will be focusing on basic sentence structure (capital letter, full stop and finger spaces). They will be practising how to hold a sentence in their head, writing it down and using their phonics to 'Fred talk' words.
History	Children will learn about the changes in their own lives. They will learn about Victorian toys and compare school life in Victorian times with school life in the modern day.
Design and technology	Children will learn about different mechanisms, sliders, winders, levers, pop ups and will then design and make their own moving picture.
Computing	Children will learn to turn on, log on, log off and shut down a computer. They will learn to use a trackpad. They will learn to create, edit and save a Word document. They will learn to use a variety of tools on Paint.
R.E.	Children will be developing their understanding of Christianity.
PSHE	Children will be discussing their ideas for class and school rules. School council reps will take the ideas generated by the class to a meeting with the headteacher.
P.E.	Children will be developing their running and jumping skills.
Music	Children will be learning songs for their Harvest Festival performance.
Handwriting	Children will develop their fine motor skills and begin to learn to write letters in cursive print.
Reading	Children will be introduced to the reading gems: predict, infer, retrieve, define, sequence, define. Children will share their enjoyment of books.
