

Year One Curriculum Map Spring 2

Maths	The children will be learning number bonds to 10/20 and counting in twos, fives and tens up to 100. They will continue to practise adding and subtracting, finding missing numbers and counting forwards and backwards to/from 100 daily.
English	This half term the children will be looking at a range of Julia Donaldson books and doing some creative writing. They will be developing key skills relating to sentence structure including punctuation (capital letter, full stop and finger spaces). Question marks and exclamation marks will be recapped and spelling rules for prefixes and suffixes will be taught.
Handwriting	Children will develop their fine motor skills and practising to write lower case letters. Some children will be introduced to pre-cursive handwriting.
Reading	Children will take part in reading gem groups daily which will work on a range of skills from retrieval of information to comprehension of a text. They will also have the opportunity to visit the library during curriculum time. Reading comprehension tasks will also be completed appropriate to their ability.
Geography	Children will learn about the continents and oceans. They will name them, locate them and learn about some of the key features. They will also focus on Kenya and the UK and compare the similarities and differences.
Art	Children will learn about textures and patterns and create rubbings in order to make a landscape piece.
Computing	Children will learn to type on a laptop. They will be able to change the size, font and colour of their writing. They will also look at the keyboard and be able to match lowercase and capital letters confidently.

R.E.	Children will be discussing Easter. They will find religious symbols of new life and think about what traditions Christians follow at Easter time.
PSHE	Children will be thinking about how to stay healthy. They will complete a range of activities linked to healthy food, getting enough sleep and exercise and keeping their bodies healthy.
P.E.	Children will be learning fundamental gross motor skills and using these through a range of team games.
Music	Children will be learning about different types of music from around the world and have a chance to play some of the instruments.
