

<p style="text-align: center;"><b><u>Science</u></b></p> <p>This half term we will be learning about animals and how they can be sorted into different groups including: mammals, amphibians, birds, fish and reptiles. We will also be learning how to use classification keys and going into Forest Schools to find out own organisms to sort.</p> <p style="text-align: center;"><b><u>R.E</u></b></p> <p>We are learning all about Christianity this half term and how Jesus was a fisher of men</p>	<p style="text-align: center;"><b><u>English</u></b></p> <p>This half term, we have started reading Meerkat mail. So far we have researched the Kalahari Desert and will be writing our own story about where Sunny, the meerkat, will travel to next. Later on in the half term we will be reading Quest an adventure picture book. The children have already read the first book in the trilogy in Year 3 which was called Journey. The children will then write their own ending to this story.</p>	<p style="text-align: center;"><b><u>Maths</u></b></p> <p>In Maths lessons this half term, the children will be focusing on numbers and place value which they will then transfer into work on addition and subtraction. There will be a focus on problem solving and reasoning as well as developing fluency with calculations.</p>
<p style="text-align: center;"><b><u>D&amp;T</u></b></p> <p>We will be looking at food and nutrition this half term in D&amp;T. The children will be designing and making a biscuit using flavours influenced from the Romans to link with their History topic. Throughout the topic, the children will look at the chronology of the invasion, Roman roads, Roman baths, Gods and Goddesses and Hadrian's Wall before bringing the topic together to explore the changes that the Romans made to Britain and the innovations they brought with them.</p>
