They will learn about the different categories of animals, what they eat and the food chain, teeth of people and animals and how this impacts on what they eat.</p> <p align="center"><b><u>R.E</u></b></p> <p>Children will learn about the Muslim faith and concentrate on their beliefs including Ramadan.</p>	<p align="center"><b><u>English</u></b></p> <p>During this half term we will finish our work on Quest a wordless adventure story. Children will create their own ending to the story. Once these areas have been completed, the children will move on to looking at multiplication and division using formal written methods. We will also be looking at fractions during this half term.</p>
