#### **Attendance**

Whole school attendance for last week was 89.4%. School target is 96%.

Please can we respectfully remind parents and carers that children should attend school unless they are unwell or have a medical appointment. Whilst we understand that birthdays are special days, taking a day off on a birthday is not acceptable and will be recorded as an unauthorised absence. A reminder that holidays in term time cannot be authorised except in very exceptional circumstances.

#### **Attendance Prize Draws**

We are introducing two prize draws in the spring term for excellent attendance. At the end of each half term, all children with attendance above 98% for the period will be entered into a prize draw to win a £20 voucher.

Each term, parents who have a child that has above 98% attendance for the period will be entered into a prize draw to win a £50 voucher. If you have more than one child, you will receive one entry per child.

## **Construction Work**

We are pleased to inform you that building work is planned to commence on Monday 22<sup>nd</sup> January on our four new classrooms on the slabbed area next to the playground. Due to the site of the construction, there will be some disruption, which will be a continually evolving process. We will keep you informed as work progresses and more details will be sent next week about drop-off and collection of children.

Some bike and scooter racks are being placed temporarily outside the main entrance in front of the offices, and between the year 4 and 5 mobiles, which can be used from next week.
