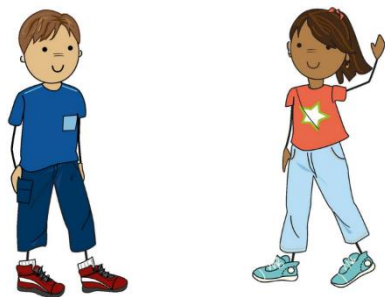




Curriculum Overview: MFL

Year 3



Les salutations (Greetings)

In this unit pupils will learn the vocabulary for basic greetings in French. Pupils will participate in a short oral conversation by the end of the unit.

Les couleurs et les nombres (Colours & Numbers)

In this unit pupils will learn to count to ten as well as learning ten popular colours in the foreign language.

Les animaux (Animals)

In this unit pupils will learn 10 familiar animals and be introduced to the verb 'I am' in French. By the end of the unit pupils will be able to recognise, recall, remember and spell up to 10 animals.

Les fruits (Fruits)

In this unit pupils will learn 10 fruits and be introduced to 'I like' and 'I do not like'. By the end of the unit pupils will have the knowledge and skills to be able to say which fruits they like and do not like.



Year 4



J'apprends le français (I Am Learning French)

By the end of the unit pupils will have the knowledge and skills to be able to introduce themselves, say how they feel and have a wider appreciation for the country/countries where French is spoken.

Les légumes (Vegetables)

In this unit pupils will learn 10 common vegetables in their plural form. They will learn the necessary vocabulary to be able to take part in a role-play activity based a vegetable market stall.

Je peux... (I Am Able...)

In this unit pupils will learn 10 familiar activities that they are able or are not able to do in French. This will allow the children to build more interesting and complex sentences including conjunctions.

Les glaces (Ice-Creams)

In this unit pupils will learn 10 flavours of ice-cream and vocabulary required to buy an ice-cream. Pupils will be able to order a cone or pot of ice-cream in the flavour(s) of their choice, specifying the number of scoops they would like.



Year 5



Je me présente (Presenting Myself)

By the end of this unit pupils will have the knowledge and skills to talk about themselves in French. Pupils will ask questions and answer using a range of personal details including name, age, where they live and nationality.



Les saisons (Seasons)

In this unit pupils will learn the 4 seasons of the year along with a key feature for each season in French. By the end of the unit pupils will have the skills and knowledge to say which is their favourite season and why.



Les vêtements (Clothes)

In this unit pupils will learn to describe what they are wearing in French. This unit brings together the grammar covered in previously so that pupils can say and write what they are packing in their suitcase for a holiday.

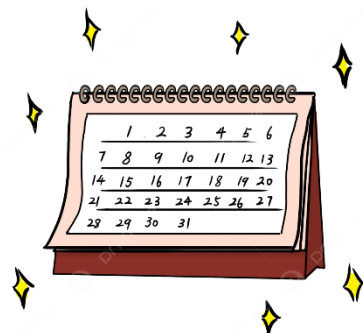


Quel temps fait-il ? (What Is the Weather?)

In this unit pupils will describe the weather and present a weather forecast. This will link vocabulary with map work and compass points. They will improve both language and cultural knowledge.



Year 6



En classe (In the Classroom)

By the end of this unit pupils will have the knowledge and skills to present about what they have and do not have in their pencil cases and/or school bag in French.

La date (The Date)

Days of the week, months of the year and numbers 1-31 will be introduced, revised and consolidated. By the end of this unit, pupils will have the knowledge and skills to say the date and when their birthday is in French.

Au salon de thé (At the Tea Room)

By the end of this unit pupils will have the knowledge and skills necessary to perform a short role-play in a French tearoom. Pupils will say and write what they are ordering using a wider range of vocabulary.
