

## Year One Curriculum Map Autumn 2

Maths	2D and 3D shape, Fractions of a shape (halves and quarters), Fractions of a quantity (halves and quarters) Place value-counting- partitioning numbers in to tens and ones up to 100.
English	'Here comes Jack Frost' by Kazuno Kohara. Children will be developing key skills relating to sentence structure including punctuation (capital letter, full stop and finger spaces). They will be challenges to use adjectives and effective vocabulary. They will be encouraged to independently spell words using their phonic knowledge.
Handwriting	Children will develop their fine motor skills and practising to write capital letters.
Reading	Children will be introduced to the reading gems: predict, infer, retrieve, define, sequence, define. Children will share their enjoyment of books.
Geography	Children will learn about the United Kingdom including the names of the countries, capital cities and human and physical features. They will also be going on a walk around the local environment to find natural and man-made features.
Science	The children will be learning about animals focusing on simple classification, their structure and what they eat (herbivores, carnivores and omnivores).
Art	Children will learn about primary colours and how to mix them to make new colours. They will be investigating what happens when we mix colours with black and white. Our work will be inspired by the work of the artist 'Wassily Kandinsky'.
Computing	Children will continue to practise how to turn on, log on, log off and shut down a computer. They will also be learning how to open and search using an internet browser. They will be developing their knowledge of how to stay safe when using the internet.
R.E.	Children will be developing their understanding of Christianity focusing on the birth of Jesus.

PSHE	Children will be celebrating differences and similarities.
P.E.	Children will be developing their ball skills and creating a dance based on the book 'rumble in the jungle'.
Music	Children will be learning Christmas songs and practising for their puppet show performance.
