

<p><u>Science</u></p> <p>This half term, the children will be looking at electricity in our Science topic. We will think about the differences between mains and battery powered electricity, create working circuits with switches and investigate different insulators and conductors as well as understanding the everyday purposes of insulators and conductors.</p> <p><u>R.E</u></p>	<p><u>English</u></p>	<p><u>Maths</u></p> <p>This half term, the children will be focusing on time before moving on to statistics. During the time topic, children will be becoming for confident with telling the time to 5 minute intervals and beyond on an analogue clock before looking at digital times on the 12 and 24 hour clock and converting times. The children will then be gathering and presenting data in the statistics topic and interpreting data presented to them in different ways in charts and graphs.</p>
