The winning classes last week 10/6/22 was 2GS with 97.3% and 6CS with 95.5 %. This year the whole school attendance is 92.5%. Please remember that school starts at 8.40am and <u>anyone arriving after 8.50am will be</u> marked as late in the register.

Warm Weather

As we approach the warmer months can we please remind parents/carers that children should be provided with a cap/sun hat and a water bottle for school. Sun cream is allowed in school but needs to have your child's name written clearly on it, which children can apply by themselves. We do advise that sun cream be applied before the school day starts, as this will provide an initial layer of protection that can then be topped up.

As stated in the school uniform policy, during warmer weather Key Stage 2 pupils may wear a white school polo t-shirt instead of their usual shirt and tie if this is more comfortable.

Start of day arrangements for years 3 and 5

As from Monday 20th June, children in years 3 and 5 can enter school via the doors on the slabbed area on the main playground instead of through the classroom doors. Year 4 already does this. Just to clarify, at the end of the school day, the collection points on the playground will remain the same. If you have any messages for your child's class teacher in the morning, please speak with a member of staff on the playground who will pass on any information.
